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

Therapeutic Storytelling: Addressing Challenging Behaviour and Developing Positive Values through the Medium of Story (Introductory Workshop)


In this one day workshop, examples, ideas and techniques for writing healing ('medicinal') stories are shared and the therapeutic use of metaphor explored. With the support of a story-making framework, the participants are guided to create their own stories addressing a range of challenging behaviours and challenging situations with children and adults.

Therapeutic Storytelling: Stories Know the Way (Advanced Workshop)

In this one day workshop we will be exploring in greater depth 'What is Imagination' and 'Why do stories know the way' (or why do stories help find the way)? There will be time allowed for questions and the sharing of ideas/stories created since the previous workshop, as well as time for some new metaphor and story-making exercises. The use of healing stories for global and national challenging situations will also be addressed.

(The preferred timing for both the above workshops is 8 hours – 9.00 to 5.00 - which includes a one hour lunch break and two half hour tea breaks. If full translation required, then allow two days).
